3. Program description

The Preparatory Course for Admission to Higher Education is a preparatory course aimed at consolidating the pre-university knowledge, in order to prepare the student for access to higher education. With a duration of 1 academic year, it allows the acquisition of linguistic and disciplinary knowledge necessary for admission to undergraduate courses in different areas at any Portuguese University. This course, designed and built to cover a wide range of areas, allows the candidate to choose the specific course units to be attended, in order to take the entrance examinations for the course he/she wishes to apply to. It consists of 8 curricular units, 4 of them compulsory, whose goals to be achieved coincide with the Program and Curricular Goals defined by IAVE, from which two optional curricular are choosen by the student according to the program they intend to enrol in.

For those not enrolled in the course, it is permitted to enrol in course units, either as isolated curricular units (for external students) or as extracurricular curricular units (for students enrolled in other UÉ courses).

4. Objectives

5. General conditions of access and admission

i Specific admission conditions

Students who have already enrolled in a 1st cycle or Integrated Master's course at the University of Évora are not allowed to enroll in this course.

The following may apply to attend the Preparatory Course for Admission to Higher Education

- students of the 12th grade who want to enter Higher Education in the next academic year;
- students who have completed the 12th grade and have not entered Higher Education;
- students who wish to enter Higher Education through the special access program for those over 23 years old;
- students from professional education who wish to enter Higher Education;
- international students who wish to apply to the international students admission competition.

ii Necessary documentation

Document proving the average and level of education of the candidate

Applicants who are not nationals of European Union countries must submit a letter of motivation consisting of a maximum of 200 words, where the motivation for attending the course and the student's future prospects are explicitly expressed.

6. Selection Process

- Academic Qualifications: 80%
 - Average grade in the highest qualification: 40%
 - Level of qualifications: 60%
- Interview: 20%
 - Understanding of Program Objectives: 50%
 - Motivation and commitment: 50%

The application for this course replaces the interview with the letter of motivation, keeping the items under evaluation, for candidates without nationality from European Union countries.

Candidates without nationality from European Union countries will be graded with 80% for the weighting relative to Literary Qualifications and 20% for the letter of motivation.

Candidates with nationality from European Union countries will be graded with 100% for weighting relative to Literary Qualifications.

The ranking grid will be filled in with the necessary adjustments in order to respect this proportionality.

7. Maximum number of admissions

- Maximum number of admissions for candidates with nationality of European Union countries: 30
- Maximum number of admissions for candidates without nationality of European Union countries: 20

Depending on the number of applications, there may be transfer of vacancies from the international students applications to the European Union students applications or vice-versa.
