3. Program description

The course is dedicated to the study of European policies for Cultural Heritage, focusing on two main areas: a) Cultural Heritage in the Mediterranean context; b) European policies and initiatives for the Mediterranean Region. The course aims to develop knowledge, skills, and generic competences in the areas of Cultural Heritage and History, with an interdisciplinary approach focused on European Studies.

4. Objectives

The course aims to: promote knowledge about the European Union and its history; promote innovative training on European policies for Cultural Heritage, in particular in the Mediterranean area; offer training that fosters dialogue between the academic world, society and policy makers; generate knowledge and develop skills that will strengthen research in European policies for Cultural Heritage.

5. General conditions of access and admission

i Specific admission conditions

Applicants may apply if they meet at least one of the following conditions:

- Holder of a Portuguese undergraduate degree or legal equivalent;
- Holders of a foreign higher education undergraduate degree that is recognized by the competent bodies of the University of Évora;
- Undergraduate students;
- Holders of a diploma/certificate of conclusion of the 12th grade of Secondary Education.

ii Necessary documentation

- Valid identification document (Identity Card, Citizen Card or Passport);
- Certificate of qualifications;
- Curriculum Vitae (maximum 5 pages).

6. Selection Process

- Academic Qualifications: 90%
 - Level of qualifications: 30%
 - Average grade in the highest qualification: 40%
 - Area of qualifications: 30%
- Curriculum Analysis: 10%
 - Professional Training in the area of the program or related fields: 100%

Priority will be given to graduates and/or undergraduate students in the areas of Cultural Heritage, History or Archaeology; International Relations and/or European Studies; Sociology and Economics. Professional experience and/or training in Cultural Heritage or European Studies will be valued.
