3. Program description

The Study Plan is made up of several Curricular Units (CUs), all optional, and students must complete a total of 12 ECTS. These curricular units are also offered in doctoral programs at the University of Évora, so that they can be credited in the respective doctoral plans.

The Course aims to provide a set of cross skills aimed at postgraduate students and early career researchers, aiming to complement the specific training offered in postgraduate programs and foster the development of technical, scientific and artistic culture.

- holder of a Bachelor's degree or legal equivalent with relevant curriculum;
- holder of a foreign higher academic degree, which is recognized by Organs competent bodies of the UE;
- holder of a research scholarship in an UE research project.
- ii Required academic qualifications Higher Education Degree 1st Cycle (Bologna) or Equivalent

iii Necessary documentation

- Valid identification document (Identity card, Citizen Card or Passport);
- Qualications certicate;
- Curriculum vitae.

- Document proving selection for awarding a research grant within the scope of a research project of UE (if it applies).
