### 3. Program description

This advanced training course “Globalization and Development Challenges” is part of the training offer of the UNESCO chair “Education and Science for Development and Human Well-Being” (EDUWELL). The interdisciplinary course seeks to develop learning in the Portuguese language, training people capable of deciding on public policies, teaching and producing research, especially in Portuguese-speaking countries. The course has 2 curricular units, which include thematic sessions, seminars and round tables, aimed at understanding and testing strategies and public policies that promote sustainable development. The course will be taught by a diverse faculty members, enabling students to a) identify causes of structural trends in the global economy; b) evaluate its impacts on developing countries; c) know strategies and public policies to promote development; d) promote economic, social and environmental sustainability; e) recognize the role of international organizations in development; f) publicize the SDGs and reflect on strategies in the face of the current environmental and climate crisis. It is intended that the student acquires knowledge and skills to evaluate and act on the multiple dimensions that characterize the globalization process, in favour of effective development strategies.

## 4. Career opportunities

The Course offers postgraduate training with 12 credits, allowing you to update your knowledge on the current context of the globalization process and the inherent challenges facing the development of countries. The Course is primarily aimed at professionals and students who intend to carry out professional activity in the transversal area "globalization, governance and development", enabling them to carry out activities in this area.

## 5. General conditions of access and admission

### i Conditions for access to the post-graduate program

Those who meet the following conditions may apply to the post-graduate program:

- Holders of the bachelor degree or legal equivalent;
- Holders of a foreign academic degree dully recognised as satisfying the objectives identical to the bachelor degree by the relevant scientific body of the higher education institution they wish to be admitted to;
- Holders of an academic, scientific or professional curriculum vitae that is recognized as attesting to the capacity to carry out this cycle of studies by the relevant scientific body of the higher education institution they wish to be admitted to.

### ii Conditions of access to the post-graduate program at Universidade de Évora

On the application date, the undergraduate students must satisfy conditions that guarantee the conclusion of their undergraduate degree until the 30th of October of the admission year. The admission and enrollment of these students is conditioned on the conclusion of the degree until this date, and the enrollment is canceled if the student does not complete the degree within that period

During the first application phase, students who have a maximum of 6 curricular units or 36 ECTS missing for conclusion of their degree can apply for the 2nd cycle; in the 2nd application phase students can apply if they have at most 3 curricular units missing and in the 3rd application phase if they have at most one curricular unit missing

The previous condition does not apply to students with a curriculum that reveals professional or scientific experience, which can be recognized by the competent scientific body, as attesting the students ability to carry out the masters degree/post-graduation, provided that the student required that recognition in the application process

### iii Specific admission conditions

Can apply to obtain this Postgraduate Degree:

- Holders of a bachelor's degree or legal equivalent;
- Holders of a foreign higher academic degree, which is recognized as meeting the objectives of the degree by the competent scientific body of the higher education institution where they wish to be admitted;
- Holders of an academic, scientific or professional curriculum, which is recognized as attesting the ability to carry out this cycle of studies by the competent scientific body of the higher education institution where they wish to be admitted.

## 6. Selection Process

- Academic Qualifications: 50%
  - Classification in the degree required in the entry conditions: 80%
  - Level of qualifications: 20%
