# 3. Program description

Human life is the basis of all citizenship rights, and the duty to know how to rescue and resuscitate is one of the foundations of active citizenship. Epidemiological evidence shows that cardiac arrest is the most urgent situation for immediate first aid; in a person in cardiac arrest each minute lost corresponds, on average, to the loss of 7% to 10% of the probability of survival. There is, therefore, no doubt about the importance of identifying an emergent situation and taking action. The aim of the course is to train the general public, in particular employees of schools, nursing homes and other institutions, to provide Basic Life Support.

### 4. Objectives

Perform BLS according to CPR/ERC rules; Use the AED according to CPR/ERC rules.

### 5. General conditions of access and admission

## i General conditions

Be over 18 years old and resident permit. If you do not have Portuguese nationality, you must have a residence permit and tax payer number .







### ii Specific admission conditions

This training is aimed at adults. No minimum academic qualification is required.

In the 1st phase/1st moment: Candidates referred by Lusitano Ginásio Clube will have preference in the selection process.

In the 2nd phase/2nd moment: Candidates referred by the Academic Association of the University of Évora and the Technical Services of the University of Évora will have preference in the selection process.

In the 3rd phase / 3rd moment: Candidates referred by the Course Committee of the Nursing Degree of the University of Évora will have preference in the selection process.

In the 4th phase / 4th moment: Candidates referred by "Associação Socio-cultural Terapêutica de Évora (ASCTE)" will have preference in the selection process.

- a) identification document;
- b) document proving the IBAN of the bank account held by the candidate, in which the name of the holder is mentioned;
- c) proof of residence permit, in the case of foreign students;
- d) document with tax identification number, in the case of foreign students;
- e) if applicable, proof of unemployment;
