3. Program description

Pharmacoepidemiology, defined as the study of the use and effects of drugs on populations, started from the need to evaluate the unexpected effects of drugs, introduced by pharmacotherapy, significantly contributing to individual and collective health and safety.

4. Objectives

The concepts and methodologies of general epidemiology, clinical epidemiology and clinical pharmacology will be explained and applied to the study of the use and effects of medicines. At the end of the course, students should have the skills and competences to consult and interpret pharmacoepidemiologic studies with different types of designs to determine which therapeutic option presents the best benefit/risk ratio.

5. General conditions of access and admission

Be over 18 years old and resident permit. If you do not have Portuguese nationality, you must have a residence permit and tax payer number .

Holders of a bachelor's degree (or legal equivalent), master's degree or doctorate in the field of health or related areas.

- c) document proving the IBAN of the bank account held by the candidate, in which the name of the holder is mentioned;
- d) proof of residence permit, in the case of foreign students;
- e) document with tax identification number, in the case of foreign students;
- f) if applicable, proof of unemployment;
