3. Program description

The aim of this course is for the student to understand the concept of patient preferences, to acquires knowledge on the instruments for their investigation and to appreciate the relevance of their integration in industry, in health regulation and in the assessment of health technologies (HTA).

4. Objectives

- Define the concept of patient preference, distinguishing it clearly from patient-reported outcome measures (PROMs) and patient-reported experience measures (PREMs);
- Recognize the importance of patient associations in providing knowledge about drug and medical device R&D processes, their contribution to patient literacy, and facilitating patient involvement in health technology assessment (HTA).
- Identify and describe good research practices in the development, design and execution of patient preference studies;
- Describe how to measure patient preference and how to interpret study results;
- Recognize the concept of value in the context of patient preference;
- Identify ways to integrate patient's preference in the industry; in the regulation of health activities and; in health technology assessment (HTA).
