3. Program description

The course aims to convey the dimension of the environmental and human health impacts of the pharmaceutical and medical devices life cycles.

4. Objectives

It is intended that the student will be able to:

- Describe the presence of drugs in the environment, identifying prevalent active compounds (PhACs) and personal care products (PCPs), main exposure routes and effects on ecosystems.
- Understand the boomerang effect concept of drugs and the role of gene-environment interaction.
- Describe the usefulness of effluent epidemiology.
- Understand the effect of climate change and pharmaceuticals on vector emergence.
- Define Ecopharmacovigilance and indicate global environmental and drug disposal regulations.
- Understand the environmental relevance of the cycle underlying the medical device.
- Understand the interaction between medical devices and sustainability and the relevance of ecodesign; Describe the environmental impacts of single-use devices compared to reusable devices, particularizing polymeric materials and biopolymers.
- Understand the relationship between medical devices and climate change.

Holders of a bachelor's degree (or legal equivalent), master's degree or doctorate in the field of health or related areas.

iii Required academic qualifications Higher Education - Degree 1st Cycle (Bologna) or Equivalent

iv Necessary documentation

- b) document(s) proving the qualifications required in the Announcement for access to the course;
- c) document proving the IBAN of the bank account held by the candidate, in which the name of the holder is mentioned;
- d) proof of residence permit, in the case of foreign students;
- e) document with tax identification number, in the case of foreign students;
- f) if applicable, proof of unemployment;
