3. Program description

This course has as its main purpose to train health professionals. Enable them to respond to the health care needs of increasingly demanding and challenging contexts. It is intended that students develop the conceptual, instrumental and relational skills that are indispensable to health care in urgency and emergency in medical-surgical and trauma contexts. Simulation, technology and different learning scenarios are strategies that foster learning and consolidation of knowledge. Course funded by PRR (MedTech - Medicine, Technology, and Future).

6. General conditions of access and admission

i Conditions for access to the post-graduate program

Those who meet the following conditions may apply to the post-graduate program:

- Holders of the bachelor degree or legal equivalent;
- Holders of a foreign academic degree dully recognised as satisfying the objectives identical to the bachelor degree by the relevant scientific body of the higher education institution they wish to be admitted to;
- Holders of an academic, scientific or professional curriculum vitae that is recognized as attesting to the capacity to carry out this cycle of studies by the relevant scientific body of the higher education institution they wish to be admitted to.

ii Specific admission conditions

Candidates must hold: Integrated Master's Degree in Medicine or Bachelor's Degree in Nursing

iii Necessary documentation

- a) identification document;
- b) document(s) proving the qualifications required in the Announcement for access to the course;
- c) document proving the IBAN of the bank account held by the candidate, in which the name of the holder is mentioned;
- d) proof of residence permit, in the case of foreign students;
- e) document with tax identification number, in the case of foreign students;

7. Selection Process

- Academic Qualifications: 40%
 - Area of qualifications: 50%
 - Level of qualifications: 25%
 - Classification in the degree required in the entry conditions: 25%
- Curriculum Analysis: 60%
 - Scientific and technical activities and publications: 25%
 - Teaching experience in training programs in the area of the program: 25%
 - Professional Experience in the area of the program or related fields: 50%

8. Maximum number of admissions

- Maximum number of admissions for candidates with nationality of European Union countries: 24
- Maximum number of admissions for candidates without nationality of European Union countries: 2

Depending on the number of applications, there may be transfer of vacancies from the international students applications to the European Union students applications or vice-versa.

9. Minimum number of students

Minimum number of students: 18

10. Tuition fee

- Candidates with nationality of European Union countries: 750,00 €
- Candidates without nationality of European Union countries: 1 000,00 €
