3. Program description

Clinical supervision in nursing is crucial to guaranteeing effective and comprehensive support in the supervisor-supervisee relationship, ensuring quality in the process of monitoring and developing personal and professional skills, for critical-reflective construction and consolidation of professional identity. The aim of this postgraduate programme is to develop nursing professionals' knowledge, skills and abilities in the field of clinical supervision of students and nurses. 6. General conditions of access and admission

i Conditions for access to the post-graduate program

Those who meet the following conditions may apply to the post-graduate program:

- Holders of the bachelor degree or legal equivalent;
- Holders of a foreign academic degree dully recognised as satisfying the objectives identical to the bachelor degree by the relevant scientific body of the higher education institution they wish to be admitted to;
- Holders of an academic, scientific or professional curriculum vitae that is recognized as attesting to the capacity to carry out this cycle of studies by the relevant scientific body of the higher education institution they wish to be admitted to.

- a) identification document;
- b) document(s) proving the qualifications required in the Announcement for access to the course;
- c) document proving the IBAN of the bank account held by the candidate, in which the name of the holder is mentioned;
- d) proof of residence permit, in the case of foreign students;
- e) document with tax identification number, in the case of foreign students;

7. Selection Process

- Academic Qualifications: 40%
 - Area of qualifications: 50%
 - Level of qualifications: 25%
 - Classification in the degree required in the entry conditions: 25%
- Curriculum Analysis: 60%
 - Scientific and technical activities and publications: 25%
 - Professional Training in the area of the program or related fields: 25%
 - Professional Experience in the area of the program or related fields: 50%

8. Maximum number of admissions

- Maximum number of admissions for candidates with nationality of European Union countries: 20
- Maximum number of admissions for candidates without nationality of European Union countries: 2

Depending on the number of applications, there may be transfer of vacancies from the international students applications to the European Union students applications or vice-versa.
