3. Program description

Micro-credential course (1ECTS) offered in partnership between the University of Evora and the National Association of Pharmacies (ANF), based on the professional activity of community pharmacists, to introduce concepts and practices that will train and boost the interest of future pharmacists in the specific area.

4. Objectives

The main objective of this course is to provide participants with the necessary knowledge about the professional activity of community pharmacists. Specifically, by the end of the training, participants are expected to:

- Understand the role of pharmacies in the healthcare system and their connection with other health services.
- Recognize the role of pharmacies in promoting public health and providing care to the population;
- Identify and understand the fundamental principles of service provision in pharmacies;
- Recognize the importance of scientific evidence generation within community pharmacy.
