### 3. Program description

Technological and scientific progress and the constant evolution of health care have enabled more and more newborns to survive prematurely or with complex pathologies. This progress, although promising, requires a high level of specialization on the part of the professionals who care for this vulnerable population. Training in Neonatology Nursing enables critical reflection on clinical practices as well as rigorous analysis of the scientific evidence that underpins current knowledge. This course is designed to promote safe, ethical and evidence-based professional practice, strengthening multidisciplinary teamwork and the humanization of neonatal care.

### 4. Objectives

- Deepen knowledge about the normal and pathological development of preterm newborns, including the main clinical and surgical conditions affecting this population.
- Develop effective, empathetic, and humanized communication skills with parents and family members, providing emotional support and promoting shared decision-making in neonatal care.
- Encourage collaboration among different healthcare professionals, contributing to the continuous improvement of care quality through the integration of knowledge.
- Critically reflect on ethical and legal challenges in neonatal care, focusing on decision-making in complex situations and advocating for the rights of the child and family.

- c) document proving the IBAN of the bank account held by the candidate, in which the name of the holder is mentioned;
- d) proof of residence permit, in the case of foreign students;
- e) document with tax identification number, in the case of foreign students;
