3. Program description

Most higher education teachers began their careers as teachers without having received any specific training for this profession. However, teaching in higher education poses several challenges that require adequate preparation, particularly of a pedagogical nature. This course promoted by the SAPIEN Consortium, implemented as a micro-credential by the University of Évora, constitutes a relevant basic training for teaching in higher education, providing knowledge of diverse teaching methods and strategies and assessment of student learning, appropriate resources to support teaching and learning, particularly digital resources, and ways of preparing and conducting teaching practices.

4. Objectives

This course aims to provide relevant basic training for teaching in higher education, and its general objectives are:

- To discuss the role of the teacher and the importance of pedagogical innovation in higher education, within the framework of current societal challenges;
- To introduce diversified teaching and assessment methods and strategies for assessing student learning and to discuss their potential;
- To introduce appropriate resources to support teaching and learning, particularly in face-to-face and distance learning environments, and to discuss how to exploit them;
- To introduce strategies for planning teaching, creating/selecting learning-promoting tasks and managing classroom dynamics, and to discuss their application;
- To envision strategies for professional teacher development.
