3. Program description

The Network Maintenance and Analysis course aims to equip students with solid knowledge and practical skills in configuring, diagnosing, monitoring, and maintaining network infrastructures. Through a theoretical-practical approach, participants explore advanced networking concepts and communication technologies, as well as traffic analysis tools and security practices in network environments. This course prepares students to operate autonomously and effectively in real-world contexts, contributing to the secure and optimized management of network systems, using active learning methodologies and up-to-date industry technologies.

4. Objectives

The Network Maintenance and Analysis course has the following main objectives:

- Understand the fundamentals of communication networks and their architectures
- Identify and configure network devices safely and effectively
- Apply best practices in hardware and software maintenance within network environments
- Use network diagnostic and monitoring tools
- Analyze and interpret network data traffic using appropriate methodologies
- Implement security measures and remote access technologies
- Develop technical autonomy in the administration and maintenance of network systems
- Relate acquired knowledge to real-world technical and professional contexts
