Introduction to Project Management in IT course offered under the Digital South + Islands project, supported by the Recovery and Resilience Plan (PRR), aimed at strengthening digital skills.

4. Objectives

This course aims to introduce students to the basic concepts of programming and in particular the Python programming language. At the end of this subject, students should be able to:

Understand the concepts of programming, algorithms and programming languages

Know the tools necessary for programming with Python

Understanding the characteristics of the Python Programming Language

Know the integer, float, string and Boolean data types, the arithmetic, relational and logical operators, and precedence rules in evaluating expressions

- d) proof of residence permit, in the case of foreign students;
- e) document with tax identification number, in the case of foreign students;
