### 3. Program description

Scientific evidence indicates that compressive therapy is a cost-effective measure in the treatment of venous ulcers of the lower limbs, promoting healing in less time and improving quality of life. This training course aims to contribute to the development of technical and scientific skills for the differential diagnosis and treatment of leg ulcers, taking into account the latest scientific evidence and training in the assessment of the Ankle-Brachial Pressure Index (ABPI) and the application of different types of short-traction bandages, long-traction bandages and multi-layer systems. The teaching methodology used in this course includes the use of advanced technological resources, namely digital environments and technological platforms applied to training and simulation.

### 4. Objectives

#### COURSE OBJECTIVES:

To contribute to the development of clinical skills for the differential diagnosis and treatment of leg ulcers;  
To develop skills in assessing the Ankle-Brachial Pressure Index (ABPI);  
To train medical staff in the technique of applying the different types of compression bandages: short traction, long traction and multi-layer systems.

#### SKILLS

Demonstrates clinical reasoning skills for differential diagnosis and decision-making in the approach

to the person with a leg ulcer;

Reveals skills in the prevention and diagnostic assessment of lower limb ulcers, based on the latest scientific evidence;

Demonstrates theoretical and practical skills in the evaluation of IPTB and Compressive Therapy.
