3. Program description

The aim of this course is to provide insights that will enable nurses and doctors to develop decision-making skills when caring for people with complex wounds across various healthcare settings. This course also aims to develop skills for assessing the psychosocial and behavioural aspects of the person with a wound and promoting their quality of life, with particular attention to the ability to develop an individualised care plan that takes into account the patient's comorbidities and unique circumstances. The postgraduate course is run in collaboration with the Portuguese Wound Society ELCOS. The course is externally accredited by the European Wound Management Association (EWMA).

4. Career opportunities

Completion of the Postgraduate Course provides advanced skills for working in hospitals – whether public, private or in the social sector – in primary healthcare units, in units and teams within the National Network for Integrated Continuing Care, as well as in other healthcare facilities and services involved in the provision of care for people with complex wounds.

6. General conditions of access and admission

i Conditions for access to the post-graduate program

Those who meet the following conditions may apply to the post-graduate program:

- Holders of the bachelor degree or legal equivalent;
- Holders of a foreign academic degree fully recognised as satisfying the objectives identical to the bachelor degree by the relevant scientific body of the higher education institution they wish to be admitted to;
- Holders of an academic, scientific or professional curriculum vitae that is recognized as attesting to the capacity to carry out this cycle of studies by the relevant scientific body of the higher education institution they wish to be admitted to.

ii Conditions of access to the post-graduate program at Universidade de Évora

On the application date, the undergraduate students must satisfy conditions that guarantee the conclusion of their undergraduate degree until the 30th of October of the admission year. The admission and enrollment of these students is conditioned on the conclusion of the degree until this date, and the enrollment is canceled if the student does not complete the degree within that period

During the first application phase, students who have a maximum of 6 curricular units or 36 ECTS missing for conclusion of their degree can apply for the 2nd cycle; in the 2nd application phase students can apply if they have at most 3 curricular units missing and in the 3rd application phase if they have at most one curricular unit missing

The previous condition does not apply to students with a curriculum that reveals professional or scientific experience, which can be recognized by the competent scientific body, as attesting the students ability to carry out the masters degree/post-graduation, provided that the student required that recognition in the application process

iii Specific admission conditions

The following are eligible to apply for the postgraduate programme:

- Holders of a bachelor's degree or equivalent qualification in Nursing or Medicine;
- Holders of a foreign higher education qualification recognised as meeting the requirements of a bachelor's degree by the relevant body of the higher education institution to which they wish to apply;
- Holders of a degree and professional qualification in the field of Nursing or Medicine.

 - Average grade in the highest qualification: 50%
- Curriculum Analysis: 60%
 - Scientific and technical activities and publications: 10%
 - Participation in research projects: 10%
 - Professional Experience in the area of the program or related fields: 15%
 - Teaching experience in training programs in the area of the program: 25%
 - Importance of positions held: 25%
 - Professional Training in the area of the program or related fields: 15%

Minimum number of students: 18
