The "Network Security" course is a training programme focused on the essential principles of network security, identifying vulnerabilities, and selecting protection techniques suited to different scenarios, including access control mechanisms and best practices in network management.

By combining theoretical sessions, theory-practice classes, and laboratory work, participants develop the skills to plan and implement secure network architectures.

- Know the basic principles of network security and identify potential vulnerabilities;
- Understand the network security methods that best apply to each situation;
- Manage networks and implement access control mechanisms;
- Plan and implement safe network architectures.

- Use and installation of tools in Windows, Linux, or macOS environments and their respective command-line interfaces;
- Basic knowledge of communication networks (types of equipment, topologies, services, among others);
- Knowledge of cybersecurity fundamentals.

iii Necessary documentation

- a) identification document;
- b) proof of residence permit, in the case of foreign students;
- c) document with tax identification number, in the case of foreign students;
