3. Program description

Advanced Project Management in IT course offered under the Digital South + Islands project, supported by the Recovery and Resilience Plan (PRR), aimed at strengthening digital skills.

4. Objectives

This course aims to empower trainees with the basic theoretical knowledge of the key IT project management methodologies and the ability to use the OpenProject platform to manage and control projects.

By the end of this course, students should acquire the following competencies:

1. Conceptual differentiation between projects and operations and mastery of the project lifecycle.
2. Methodology selection (Waterfall, Agile, or Hybrid) suitable for specific project scenarios.
3. Structured definition of requirements, scope, and critical project milestones.
4. Mastery of OpenProject for creating tasks, managing deadlines, and monitoring progress.

5. General conditions of access and admission

i General conditions

Be over 18 years old and resident permit. If you do not have Portuguese nationality, you must have a residence permit and tax payer number .

ii **Specific admission conditions**

Enrollment in a bachelor's degree program in a Non-CTEAM field or holding a Bachelor's degree in a Non-CTEAM field. Only applicants who, at the time of application in SIUE, attach proof (certificate of completion, enrollment, etc.) of the stated condition will be admitted.

iii **Required academic qualifications** Secondary education (12th year of complete education) or equivalent

iv **Necessary documentation**

- a) identification document;
- b) document(s) proving the qualifications required in the Announcement for access to the course;
- c) document proving the IBAN of the bank account held by the candidate, in which the name of the holder is mentioned;
- d) proof of residence permit, in the case of foreign students;
- e) document with tax identification number, in the case of foreign students;
